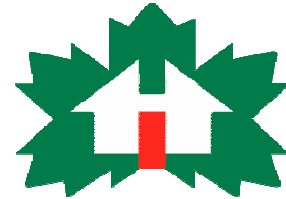

Why Should I Replace my Windows?

Choosing whether or not to replace your old windows can be an easy choice. You can feel drafts coming through the window, you can see condensation on the glass, or maybe your windows don't operate properly. 1: Vinyl Windows

Vinyl windows are the most cost effective approach. Vinyl windows from Heritage Millwork are maintenance free, and come with a lifetime warranty. Some styles even have warranty coverage when you break a piece of glass. Their low cost, combined with all of the energy efficient glass options available, make vinyl windows a very desirable choice. They are available in two colours, white or tan. All of the typical window styles; slider, case-ment, awning, single-hung, double hung, and picture windows are available.

Vinyl windows are made from *polyvinyl chloride*, a derivative of oil, and are sustainable for around 20–30 years, providing they are kept clean, and all hardware is kept in good working order. Vinyl windows are great for people looking to make upgrades to their home prior to selling, or to improve the "curb-appeal" of an older home.

2: Wood Windows

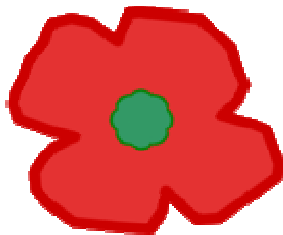
